GDASS (Gloucestershire Domestic Abuse Support Service) is a county-wide service designed to reduce the level of domestic abuse and improve the safety of victims and their families.

Despite current restrictions, GDASS are still in operation and are working hard with their partner agencies to ensure its business as usual for those experiencing domestic abuse

GDASS are having to be more creative with how they do this, but they are still supporting existing clients and their helpdesk and online forms are still working for those who need support who may not have spoken to GDASS before

GDASS can still help get people out of abusive households, they can still help people get to places of safety, and they are still working closely with the Police to hold perpetrators of abuse to account
